To serve the Haitians living and working in the sugarcane bateyes of the Pominican Republic

The Need:

More than 250 batey communities exist in the Pominican Republic. These simple communities of one-room houses are home to estimates as high as 1,000,000 Haitians. These communities face extreme poverty and food insecurity. The men work 14 - 16 hour days making less than \$2 US a day. Women and children are the most vulnerable. These communities have little or no access to clean water, electricity, education, healthcare, or legal rights. The COVID-19 pandemic has only compounded these issues for the Haitians as much of the care opportunities they receive come from missions and aid groups who have been forced to pause relief efforts due to COVID related restrictions.

- Restore dignity and empower families
- Invite others into Christ's kingdom here on earth
- Bridge communities and create sustainable economic pathways beyond the bateyes

We will be partnering with other IM Global Servants and working in conjunction with the Good Samaritan Hospital in La Romana, the Oasis of Peace ministry center, and Baptist Alliance churches in the Pominican Republic. We will operate as ministry multipliers, hosting short-term mission teams and directing resources to meet the ever-growing needs in these Haitian communities, needs like construction, medical and health awareness, education, agriculture, and spiritual development through VBS and worship opportunities. We are committed to a first term of service for 5 years in the Pominican Republic.
